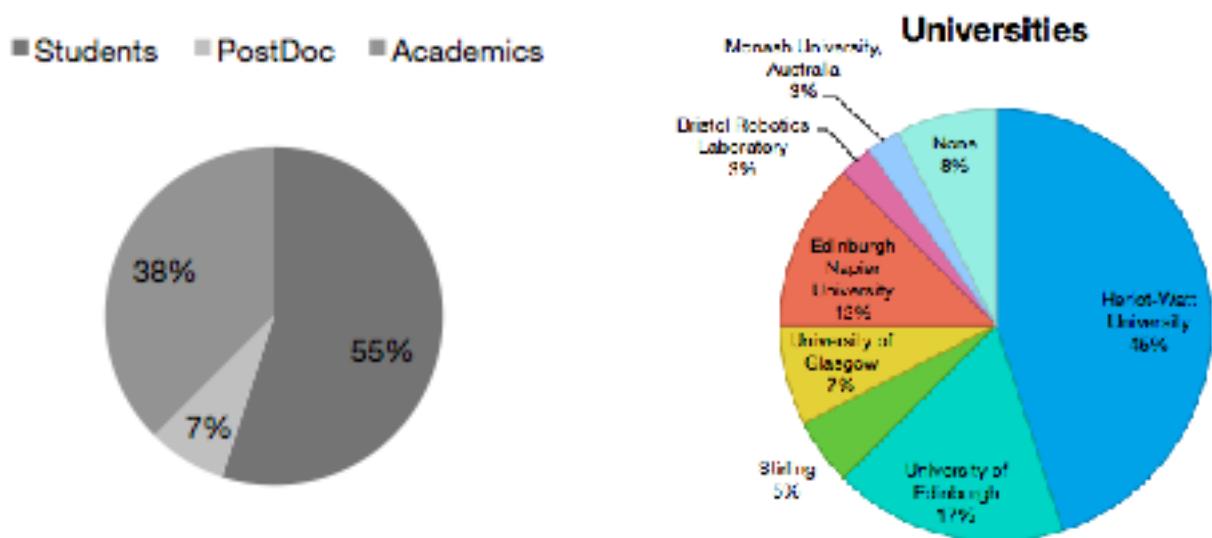
The workshop has covered a broad range of topics from Machine learning and AI to Cognitive Architectures to Sensing and Understanding Human behaviours.
