

MMnet'13 Workshop on Language and Runtime Support for Concurrent Systems

On Wednesday May 8th, Heriot-Watt University hosted the MMnet'13 Workshop on Language and Runtime Support for Concurrent Systems

This was the twelfth instance of a series of workshops of the EPSRC-funded UK Memory Management Network, which was established in 2002 and typically organises one workshop per year, as recorded on its web page (<http://www.mm-net.org.uk/>). For this instance we had a total of 32 registrations, mostly from the UK but also two participants from Paris, France, and one speaker from Codeplay Software, Ltd, an Edinburgh-based company specialising on compiler and tool support for heterogeneous, massively parallel hardware. The programme of the workshop featured 10 talks in total, some of them presentations developed for other high-profile venues. MMnet'13 itself was not refereed, but links to the slides and in some cases papers on the presented topic are given on the main web page.
