

SICSA Cyber Security Research Theme Small Grants 2019

The SICSA Cyber Security research theme invites proposals to support Scottish Cyber Security researchers in carrying out research activities over the summer of 2019. We anticipate applications for three types of activities (or a combination):

- a) Travel (max £250);
- b) Equipment (max £500);
- c) Studentship (max £1000)

While there is no restriction on the topics, we encourage applications to research into new cyber-related areas and those that are difficult to find funding for. Example topics include (not limited to) human-centred cyber security, misinformation detection (fake news), media privacy and security, digital rights management, blockchain, policy and practices, ethics etc.

Eligibility

Any academic working within a SICSA-member institution. Preference will be given to early career researchers (PhD students and those within 7 years of graduation from PhD).

Conditions of Funding

Grant holders are required to write a report once the research has been completed, detailing outcomes, outputs and potential impact.

The funding cannot be used to support research that is already funded by another award.

Selection

All applications will be ranked independently by the two SICSA theme leaders, who will meet and agree on a final ranking within one month of the closing-date.

Application Process
